Re: "You, Fireworks and City of Bothell"

Dear Chestnut Glen Neighbor,

"Fourth of July is coming up: do you know what the rules are for fireworks?"

State-approved Class C fireworks are allowed in the City of Bothell on specific dates. Fireworks can be sold between July 1 through July 4. Fireworks can be discharged on July 4th ONLY, from 9 am – 11 pm. Washington State Patrol maintains the list of legal fireworks. Firecrackers, salutes, chasers, skyrockets and bottle rockets are not allowed. For further information, please visit the Washington State Patrol website at <http://www.wsp.wa.gov/fire/fireworks.htm> or call toll free 1-888-295-8594. You must be at least 16 to purchase fireworks and at least 18 to discharge fireworks. Discharging fireworks is not allowed at City or public – owned parks. Schools, churches, and private facilities should be contacted and approval granted before any discharge occurs on their property.

Complaints? To report the use of illegal devices or any fireworks use outside of approved discharge hours (July 4, 9 am – 11 pm) dial 911. Please keep in mind that City police resources will be stretched thin during the fireworks season and may not be able to respond immediately.
